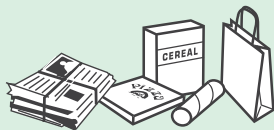


NEW YORK CITY RECYCLING TIPS

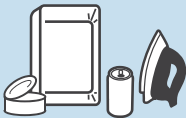
PAPER

METAL

Cans, Foil &
Mostly Metal



GLASS

ONLY
Bottles & Jars



PLASTIC

ONLY
Bottles & Jugs



CARDBOARD



No hardbound books, soiled paper:
towels, napkins, plates, cups.

BEVERAGE CARTONS: Milk Cartons, Juice Boxes, Etc.



Empty and rinse before recycling.

Place **paper** and **metal/glass/plastic/beverage cartons** in separate clear bags or labeled bins.
