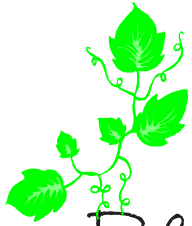


Come to the Y's Environmental Fair

Bring these recyclables to the Fair -- you can recycle SO much, right here in Riverdale. We'll show you how ...

- WearableCollection used textiles (clothing, towels, sheets, etc.)
- Electronics (everything except TVs and small household appliances such as toasters, microwaves, vacuums, etc.).
- CFL (compact fluorescent lightbulbs, unbroken)
- Rechargeable batteries
- Recycle your used athletic shoes with Nike Reuse-A-Shoe and help us turn them into Nike Grind, a material used in sports surfaces like tracks, playgrounds and gym



Bring your old Crocs!

Crocs recycles and donates your used Crocs to impoverished countries via their SolesUnited program.

New this Year: Stop 'n Swap *Free!*

Bring clean, working and portable items you no longer need (including clothing), but this is not required. Please do not bring furniture or other large items that cannot be carried away easily.
