

Recycling Monitor Badges: Front



Directions: Print double sided, in color, preferably on cardstock; Laminate sheet; Use scissors or a 3" circle punch to cut out badges; Use hole punch to make hole in space between words at top of badge; Tie through a length of yarn long enough to fit comfortably over student's head.
