

Got Milk?

Then make an upcycled Milk Money Wallet!

SUPPLIES NEEDED

- Velcro
- ruler
- scissor
- school milk carton



1. Cut one panel along the corner crease from the top to the bottom. Do not remove the panel from the carton, leave it attached.

2. Measure 2 1/4" from the bottom of the carton.

Cut through the other 3 adjoining carton panel walls.

After finishing milk, rinse carton out well and air dry for 24-hours.



After cutting the 3 adjoining carton panel walls the carton will look like this.

3. From the bottom of the carton where the long panel is attached, cut diagonally across to the top corner edges of the 2 perpendicular panels.

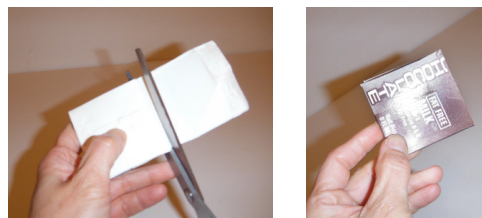
After the two triangles are cut off/removed, the carton will look like this.



4. Fold in the small triangle panels this will create a flat pocket.

5. Turn the carton upside down. Fold the longest panel over and cut off the material that extends beyond the carton bottom.

6. Cut rounded corners on the "cover" panel.

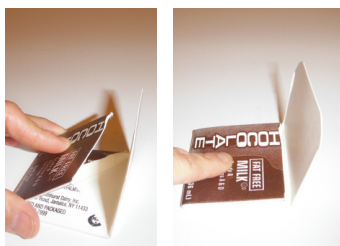


7. Fold in the two corners again to create a flat pocket.

8. Cut a small piece of Velcro.

Adhere the Velcro on the inside of the "cover" panel and affix the mate to the outside of the "pocket"

Presto, you just created a Milk Money Wallet!
