


ACTIVITY I-Dot Survey

This activity is a simple and fun way to measure student environmental habits & awareness.



Materials:

Butcher Paper Tape Stickers (optional) Markers

Assembly Directions:

• Cut a piece of butcher paper (6'-8' long depending on the wall space)

Draw a large "I" in the middle of the sheet
Around the "I" draw large "thought balloons" that connect the following phrases or ideas to the "I" in the center of the paper. Be mindful to leave enough space in each of the balloons for participants to leave stickers.

Sample survey phrases may include:

- I...Encourage my friends to recycle
- I...Reuse materials (ex. write on both sides of the paper)
- I...Turn off lights when leaving the room
- I...Believe recycling makes a difference
- I...Reduce my waste (use a refillable water bottle, etc.)
- I...Remind my family to recycle at home
- I...Sort my waste into the correct bins in the cafeteria

Participant Directions:

Ask students to place a sticker in each of the "thought balloons" that corresponds with an item or action that they do to benefit the environment. Students are encouraged to place stickers in as many categories that are true for them.

Modifications:

- In place of stickers, students can write their name or add a checkmark in each category.
- Use different colored stickers/markers to distinguish responses from different grades, schools, classes, etc.
