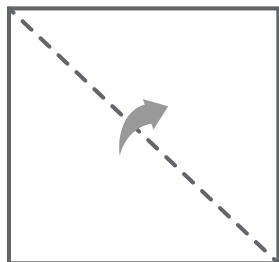




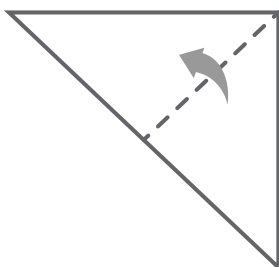
ACTIVITY RRR SNOWFLAKE

Traditional paper snowflakes are fun and easy to make. Follow the instructions below to fold and cut paper. Consider using used paper, magazines, flyers, etc.

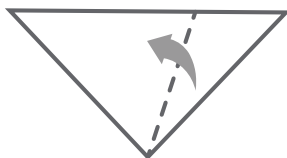
SCRAP PAPER SNOWFLAKES

FUN FACT: Did you know that no two snowflakes have the same pattern?!



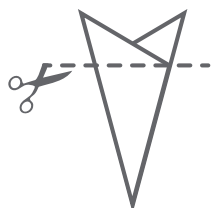
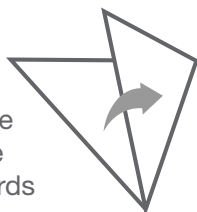
Fold the paper in half diagonally into a triangle



Fold the triangle in half so the corners meet



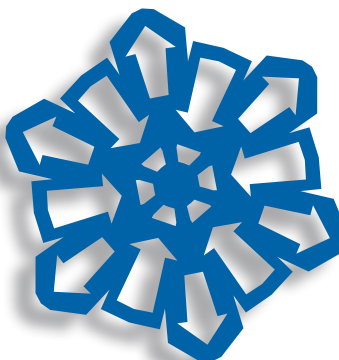
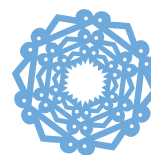
Fold the triangle into thirds



Cut across the folded paper so that it looks like a triangle



Now, create your snowflake



Materials

Paper (cut into square shape)
Scissors

Steps

1. Fold the paper in half diagonally to make a triangle.
2. Fold the triangle in half so the corners meet.
3. Fold the triangle into thirds.
4. Cut across the folded paper so it looks like a triangle.
5. Cut into the triangle to make your beautiful and unique paper snowflakes.
6. When your done, unfold it gently.

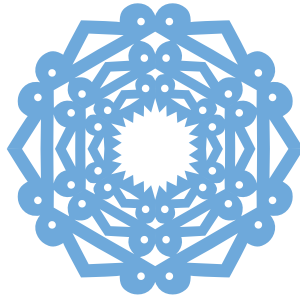
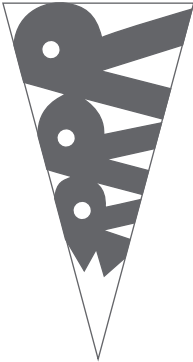
